



Several different cultural layers have emerged and values of different nationalities became intermixed.



In 1998 Pécs was given the UNESCO prize *Cities for peace* for maintaining the cultures of the minorities, and also for its tolerant and helping attitude toward refugees of the Balkan Wars

UNIVERSITY OF PÉCS

Academic education was started in 1367, when the first university of the country was founded in Pécs. Today's university has been dynamically developing and expanding since the 1920s.

- 10 faculties and 210 majors
- More than 30.000 students in Pécs
- Education is in Hungarian, but there is English language education at Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Economics and there is German language education at the Faculty of Medicine.
